## "HISTORIC GREER" (slide presentation)

Joada Hiatt is the manager of the Jean M. Smith Library of Greer. She is the Chairperson of the city of Greer's Architectural Review Board to review historic properties. She was formerly on the Greer Festival Board and did historic bus tours, and presently does tours for the Greater Greer Chamber of Commerce Leadership programs. With a slide presentation and stories, she will tell us of Greer and its surrounding area. Greer sits on the old Indian boundary lines which were significant in many ways to its history.
