G. Anne Sheriff, a teacher for 34 years, received the SC DAR History Teacher Award. She and her students published books on local history and genealogy, which are available at the library. Serving as volunteer curator of the Faith Clayton Genealogical Collection at Southern Wesleyan University, she has organized the collection of books, family histories and original documents. She is also volunteer curator of the Central History Museum and organized the Tri-County Museum Consortium. She will speak to us on the Faith Clayton collection, her books, and her experiences.

Betty Monahan introduced the speaker, Madelyn Butts, a member of the Chapter. She presented a very interesting program on genealogy and computers.
